

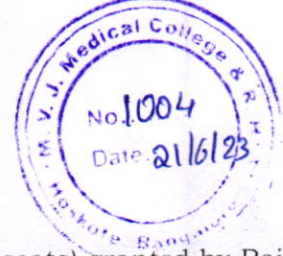

Subject: Continuation of Recognition of MBBS degree (150 seats) granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka in respect of the student being trained at MVJ Medical College and Research Hospital, Bangalore, Karnataka.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your application for grant of Continuation of Recognition of MBBS degree (150 seats) awarded by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka in respect of the students being trained at MVJ Medical College and Research Hospital, Bangalore, Karnataka and to say that your college was assessed by the Assessors appointed by MARB to conduct virtual assessment during the final MBBS practical Examination on 23rd & 24th March, 2022 and physical verification of the facilities on 3rd January, 2023. Both the assessment reports were considered in the Undergraduate Medical Education Board, an autonomous Board of the Commission.

2. The above assessment reports alongwith the data available on AEBAS and HMIS including CCTV footage was considered in Under Graduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) and certain deficiencies were noted. The same were communicated to the college authorities vide UGMEB's letter dated 15.05.2023 for compliance.

3. In response to the above, the Principal, M.V.J. Medical College and Research Hospital, Bangalore submitted their reply with regard to the deficiencies pointed out by UGMEB in its letter dated 22.05.2023. Subsequently, an opportunity of the personal hearing was also given to the college authorities on 30.05.2023.

4. After hearing the college authorities and careful consideration of the facts and compliance, it has been decided by the UGMEB that MVJ Medical College and Research Hospital is granted **one year** Recognition of MBBS qualification in respect of the students admitted in the year 2018-19. However, they shall apply afresh for Continuation of Recognition in 2024.


5. Accordingly, the approval of the competent authority in UGMEB is hereby conveyed for grant of **CONTINUATION OF RECOGNITION FOR ONE YEAR** for MBBS degree for 150 students, granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka in respect of the students being trained at MVJ Medical College and Research Hospital, Bangalore, Karnataka.

6. However, the college authorities are advised to apply afresh to UGMEB in 2024 for Continuation of Recognition, at least 6(six) month prior to the final examination of MBBS Part-II(Practical) alongwith the requisite fee i.e. Rs. 3.54 lakhs only.
