
Sir,

No separate notification in the Official Gazette is being issued in this regard as the MBBS degree awarded by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore is already notified as recognized qualification and included in the Schedule to the IMC Act, 1956.

This issues with the approval of competent authority.


