In continuation to this office letter No. MCI 34(41)UG/2011- Kar-24/9209, dated 10.05.2011, on the subject noted above, this is to inform you that compliance verification assessment report dated 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2011 alongwith the previous assessment report (11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2011) has been considered by the Board of Governors and the Board of Governors decided that the recognition of MBBS degree granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at MVJ Medical College and Research Hospital, Bangalore be continued restricting the number of admissions to 100 (Hundred) students per year.
