Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore -Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) & Sub: DCH qualification in respect of students being trained at MVI Medical College, Bangalore.

Sir.

I am directed to state that the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India considered the assessment report (April, 2011) on the standard of examination and other teaching and training facilities available at M.V.J. Medical College, Bangalore for recognition of MD(Paediatrics) & DCH qualification granted by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of increased intake and it was decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (May, 2011) and decided to recommend that MD(Paediatrics) qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences and Research Centre, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at MVJ Medical College, Bangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the LM.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2(Two) students per year.

The Board of Governors further considered the Council Assessor report (May, 2011) and noted that DCH is already recognized with 2(Two) seats and now the matter is consideration of recognition of the course for increase of seats i.e. 2(Two) to 3(Three); hence decided to recommend that DCH qualification granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at M.V.J. Medical College, Bangalore be recognized restricting the number of admissions to 3(Three) students per year.

The attention of the institute is drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-cluase-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.
